### **Benefits**



Reinforcement

The idea of shared good practice



**Alignment** 

Use of the same tools and processes by all Councils.



**Experience** 

Staff involved in PAT would be familiar with the toolsets and processes.



Consistency

All Councils using the "same test language".



**Oversight** 

Easy tracking dependencies between concurrent implementations



**Efficiency** 

As implementations proceed, test cases to be written from scratch are likely to reduce significantly.
